
Dear Mr. Conger:

Thank you very much for your response to my inquiry on the proposed Mill Pond wind turbine project in my Eastern North Carolina congressional district. This proposal has generated a great deal of concern among local residents for a variety of reasons, not the least of which is potential impact on Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point and Marine Corps Air Station New River.
